

Family Reading Guide for: *The Greatest Adventure* by Tony Piedra

Below are some comments and questions to use when you share this book with your child. Pick a few that interest you and maybe add some of your own! The idea is to enjoy sharing the book with your child and talking about it as you read.

Explore the story together, talk about it, and most of all have FUN!

Note: Page number 1 is the first page of the story with writing. Before they first share the book with their child, some people like to put small numbered sticky notes or *very* light pencil markings in the book to tell them what page they are on. It does make it easier to use these questions!

The first page of this book begins with the words Eliot was a great adventurer.

1–2	What is Eliot pretending?
5	Who is telling Eliot it's "dinner time"?
9–10	What kind of animals did Eliot's grandfather see on his adventures?
13–14	Where are Eliot and his grandfather going to have an adventure?
17–18	What does Eliot see instead of jungles, sharks, or whales?
23–24	What are some of the different things you can see inside the boat?
29–30	Why do you think Eliot's grandfather gives him his hat? How does Eliot feel getting his grandfather's hat?
31–32	What's happening on this page? Is this adventure happening in real life or in their imagination? Why?
