Art Activity:

Cotton Ball Snowman



Use cotton balls, glue, and construction paper to have your child create their own snowman. You can even add sticks and googly eyes for added decorations.

Science & Language Arts Activities:

Snow Sensory Bin

First, cover the table with a cloth. Next, place some freshly fallen snow in a shallow plastic container and place it on the covered table. Then, fill the container with a variety of small toys. Finally, let your child have fun playing in the snow!
