

Family Reading Guide for:

Pete the Cat: I Love My White Shoes by Eric Litwin

Below are some comments and questions to use when you share this book with your child. Pick a few that interest you and maybe add some of your own! The idea is to enjoy sharing the book with your child and talking about it as you read.

Explore the story together, talk about it, and most of all have FUN!

Note: Page number 1 is the first page of the story with writing. Before they first share the book with their child, some people like to put small numbered sticky notes or *very* light pencil markings in the book to tell them what page they are on. It does make it easier to use these questions!

3	What is your favorite thing to wear? How does it make you feel?
5	What is your favorite fruit to eat? What color would it turn your shoes if you stepped in it?
7	How do you usually feel when you cry?
13	What do you like to do when you are walking along?
15	Pete is singing in the rain. Can you think of a rain song we can sing together?
Various	Let's sing Pete's song together.
17	What is happening on this page? Can you figure out where Pete is?
23	What are some things we wash?
24	How do you think Pete feels in this picture?
30	Would you like to be Pete's friend? Why?
