#### **Arts and Crafts:**

## **Handprint Pete**



Paint your child's palm blue and have him/her carefully place it on a piece of white paper to make a print. Once the handprint is dry, add the head, face and sneakers to finish Pete!

# **Sneaker Lacing Board**



#### Materials needed:

- one shoelace
- one piece of cardboard
- one kid's sneaker to trace
- Markers or crayons

Follow the instructions on the video. Allow your child to decorate the sneaker with markers and/or crayons. After you add a shoelace, have your child practice tying the shoe.

#### Science:

## **Color Mixing**



The purpose of this activity is to demonstrate to children how the primary colors – red, blue, and yellow – mix to form the secondary colors – green, orange, and purple.

You will need:

- ice cube trays
- •red, blue, and yellow food coloring
- •warm water
- •3 bowls
- 7 glasses or other clear containers such as jars.

Make five ice cubes of each color and dilute the food coloring with water. Please note: If you use warm water for this activity, it speeds up the melting process of the ice cubes. You may like to slow down the melting process by adding cold water instead.
