

# Pete the Cat: I Love My White Shoes Extension Activities for the Classroom

#### **Games:**

## **Sequencing Story Path:**




First, cut out red, blue, brown and white sneaker prints, as well as pictures of blueberries, strawberries, a bucket of water and mud. Laminate them if you can. After reading the book, have your students walk on the footprints and through the fruit, mud and puddle. Have them retell the story as they go along.

You can change it up by adding different pictures of things Pete could step in. Then of course you would need to make additional colored sneaker prints that correspond to the new pictures.

## **Sorting Shoes:**

Collect one shoe from each student (and the teacher)! There are so many ways you can sort shoes. Here are some examples to get you started:

- How the shoes close (laces, Velcro, elastic, or no closure)
- Types of shoes (boots, sandals, flip flops, tennis shoes/sneakers)
- Shoes good for running (tennis shoes/sneakers, soccer shoes)
- By texture (smooth, bumpy etc.)
- Shoes with heels and shoes that are flat
- Designs on the soles of the shoes
- Patterns and designs on the shoes (stripes, pictures, letters, etc.)



### Pin the Shoe on Pete:


