

Family Reading Guide for:

Dragons Love Tacos by Adam Rubin

Below are some comments and questions to use when you share this book with your child. Pick a few that interest you and maybe add some of your own! The idea is to enjoy sharing the book with your child and talking about it as you read.

Explore the story together, talk about it, and most of all have FUN!

Note: Page number 1 is the first page of the story with writing. Before they first share the book with their child, some people like to put small numbered sticky notes or *very* light pencil markings in the book to tell them what page they are on. It does make it easier to use these questions!

The first page of this book begins with the words Hey, kid!

1–2	Let's count all the dragons on these two pages.
3–4	Can you think of other reasons dragons love tacos? How do you feel about tacos?
8	What toppings do you enjoy on tacos?
9	How is the dragon feeling?
11–12	What other kinds of parties have you been to?
15	What would happen if the dragons found the spicy salsa?
17	What do you like best about parties? Which dragon is most like you at a party?
21	Have you ever eaten a jalapeño pepper? What does it taste like?
23–24	What is happening to all of the dragons?
25	How is the boy feeling now?
27	Why is the home being rebuilt?
29	What is your favorite part of the story?
