Literacy:

Do a shared reading poem: Monkeys Monkeys in the tree, throw the _____ hat down to me!

Have paper hats or pictures of hats to switch out the color



Math:

Work on sorting and stacking using cubes, stacking toys etc. to count and sort items of different colors.

Games and Music:

Monkey Freeze Dance

Play this game like you would the traditional game of Freeze Dance. However, when the music plays, instead of dancing, the kids will walk and jump around like monkeys. When the music stops, the monkeys must freeze in place. Any player who doesn't freeze right away is out of the game. Continue playing until only one player remains. They are the winning monkey dancer.



Who's the Monkey?

Gather players and choose one to be the guesser. That child leaves the room. The rest of the players choose another person to be the monkey. That player starts to move around like a monkey. The rest of the players copy the motions of the player who is the monkey. The guesser is brought back into the room to watch the movements of the crowd. Every time the monkey changes movements, the rest must quickly follow, trying not to give away who is the monkey. When they guess correctly, they get to choose which player has to be the guesser for the next round.
