| Educator - (To the Parent/Guardian): | |
| | Your child is in the Story Leaders reading program. Story Leaders are children who read and explore books in the classroom, and also get to bring those books home to keep. |
| | At home, you and your child will need to set aside some time for hear-and-say reading; a time when you read the new books together. Hear-and-say reading is a shared reading practice where the child becomes the storyteller and the adult is the questioner and active listener. This will help your child succeed in building their literacy skills. |
| | Now, we will watch a video showing the best ways to read with your child, and |
| | then, at the end of the video there will be time for questions. |
| | I will also show you the special book plate in the Story Leaders book that will help you remember the important points of what we've learned. |
