

If You Give a Pig a Pancake Extension Activities for the Classroom

Language Arts:

Beginning Sound Pancakes

Cut out cardboard circles for the pancakes and yellow squares for the butter. On the pancakes, glue pictures of various objects. On each butter square, glue a letter (capital, lower case or both). Have each student create their own plate of pancakes, making sure they match the pancakes to the butter.

Construction:

Build a Treehouse







Using blocks, Legos, or popsicle sticks, have your students build a treehouse, like Pig built in the story.

Songs and Rhymes:

"Ten Little Piggies"

Continue with nine, eight, seven etc.
