#### Art:

### Pete the Cat Headband




Have each student glue eyes, ears, a nose, and whiskers onto a blue strip of paper to make Pete's face. Help them measure their heads and staple the bands to fit. Now, have all those cats act out the story as you read!

## **Shoe Prints**



Trace each child's shoes, or have them trace, on large sheets of paper. Decorate traced shoes with paint/markers, decorate both types with school related stickers.

\*These paper shoes can be used for the "Pete Says" game below.

#### **Games:**

# "Pete Says" Game

Tape paper shoe shapes around the room (on the floor). Children stand on their shoes and play "Pete Says" ("Simon Says"). For at least one instruction, use the shoe cutouts: "Pete Says step in front of your paper shoes," "Jump off your paper shoes," "Jump on your paper shoes." For your last instruction, sing, "Pete the Cat: Rocking in My School Shoes" and tell the students, "Pete Says to start rocking!" Want to hear how the song/chant can sound?
