

Family Reading Guide for:

Jabari Tries by Gaia Cornwall

Below are some comments and questions to use when you share this book with your child. Pick a few that interest you and maybe add some of your own! The idea is to enjoy sharing the book with your child and talking about it as you read.

Explore the story together, talk about it, and most of all have FUN!

Note: Page number 1 is the first page of the story with writing. Before they first share the book with their child, some people like to put small numbered sticky notes or *very* light pencil markings in the book to tell them what page they are on. It does make it easier to use these questions!

The first page of this book begins with the words "I'm making a flying machine today!"

Cover	Can you tell me what happens in this book?
2	Did the machine fly on the first try?
5	What is Jabari wearing? Where have you seen that before?
11	Do you like when your brothers or sisters or other people try to help you?
14-15	What color is the machine? What color would your flying machine be?
16-17	How can you tell that Jabari is upset?
18-19	What do you do to feel better when you are frustrated? Can we take a deep breath together?
24-25	Why did the machine fly this time?
27	How is Jabari feeling now?
28	If you made a flying machine, where would you make it go?
