Fun with Food:

Bagel Fish

Ingredients: half a bagel (or waffle), cream cheese, food coloring, banana slices, blueberries, clementines, and optional sprinkles



Arts and Crafts:

Handprint Goldfish



Materials needed: White paper, scissors, orange paint, black markers and googly eyes

What's Missing?

This game is simple to set up and just as easy to play. Here's how:

- Show the students the pet-related objects on the tray.
 For children just starting, stick to 3–4 objects. As they get older and gain confidence with the game, more items can be added to provide a greater challenge.
- Identify each object with the students.
- Students close their eyes, and the teacher takes a small blanket or handkerchief and covers the tray.
- The teacher picks up one item and removes it from the tray.
- Students open their eyes and identify which item is missing from the collection.

(sung to the tune of "The Wheels on The Bus")

Snap, snap, snap . . . (hold two hands together, joined at the wrist, to form a mouth, snap open and shut)
